TRASH COLLECTION: If your service day falls on a holiday your service will be on Tuesday.

Example: If Monday is a holiday you will be serviced on Tuesday

YARD WASTE: If your service day falls on a holiday your service day will be on the next scheduled pick up day

Example: If Wednesday is a holiday your collection day will be the next Wednesday.

BULK COLLECTION: If your service day falls on a holiday your service day will be the next scheduled pick up day.

Example: If Saturday is a holiday your collection day will be next Saturday.



BULKY ITEMS COLLECTIONS

What is bulky waste? Bulky waste includes household items that are normally collected but do not fit in the cart, such as couches, chairs, mattresses, tables, carpets, painted/stained wood, etc. The collection of these types of items is available to all residents on Saturday and is limited to three items per collection. The bulky items collection is for waste that is not included in the weekly automated collection. Please keep large items away from the trash carts as they will interfere with the automated collection of the cart.

Automated Trash Collection

Automated collection is a technologically advanced system of refuse and collection and disposal. The system is called “automated” because a special truck, equipped with a mechanical/robotic arm, automatically lifts and empties special trash and containers without the driver ever leaving the cab of the truck. This is a system designed to improve the efficiency of disposing of trash, make the task of putting out trash easier and cleaner for the resident, improve the appearance of the Town and greatly reduce the injury potential for our employees.

The new automated system is safer, more efficient and requires less labor to collect solid waste. In addition, because the mechanical arm performs all the lifting, there is no risk of injury to the driver. Each residence will be receiving curbside service and will be provided with a container: one 96-gallon wheeled totter at no cost. The new system is the next step in improving trash service to our customers.

Using the new automated system is easy! On your regular trash collection day, you simply place your household trash into the supplied blue 96-gallon wheeled cart and place your container in the street with the lid opening facing the street. Your containers must be at least three feet from objects (including parked vehicles, fire hydrants, etc.) on either side and at least two feet apart from each other. Your cart must be placed at the curb by 6:30 am on your collection day. Trash collection takes place once each week for each Town of Forest Heights resident. All bagged garbage must be placed inside the cart; if not, it will not be collected.

Roll-out Carts

The benefits of roll-out carts have been well documented based on hundreds of programs across North American.

Benefits are simple:

Cleanliness: Roll-out carts keep odors in and vermin and animals out. Greater stability and the attached lid mitigates spills, keeping your streets clean and aesthetically pleasing.

User Friendly: The cart body having ample handle space for pushing and pulling makes disposal of household solid waste and recyclables a pleasant task. A large lid and handle so you don't have to touch the underside of the lid when opening. The foot tilts back enabling the carts large wheels to be used easing the moving, to and from your curb.

Safety: Since mechanical lifters are utilized in the dumping process, roll-out carts are needed to meet the ever increasing demands of safety regulations. Prior to this automated technology garbage collection was one of the most dangerous jobs in America.

Roll-Out Carts Do's

- Following instructions from the Town of Forest Heights on collection day
- Close lid before moving cart
- Email Goode Companies if you have any questions about your cart csr@goodecompanies.com
- Keep fingers and hands clear of cart when closing
- Clean out cart periodically with water

Roll-Out Carts Don'ts

- Don't overfill the cart-make sure lid closes completely
- No hot coals or ashes in the cart
- No hazardous waste (paint cans, solvent or dead animals) in cart
- Don't store cart near heat or gas
- Don't move/tilt cart with open lid
- Don't drag or play around cart
- Don't sit or stand on top of the lid or cart body
